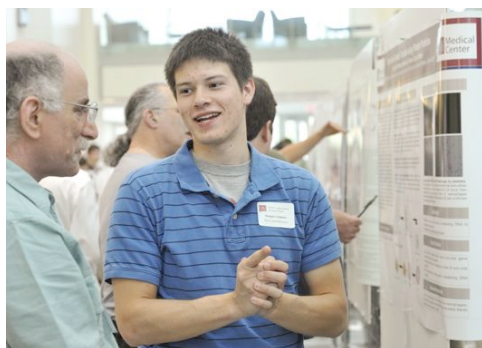
### MAPS Research Forum schedule
